This is an exciting year for Habitat AND our community! No doubt most everyone has learned that President Jimmy and Roselyn Carter are coming in August to help build Habitat homes. Also coming for this Work Project are Garth Brooks and Trisha Yearwood! The plan is for 21 homes to be built (in Mishawaka), providing opportunities for 2,000 volunteers! A total of \$4.7 million is the estimated need to complete the Carter Work Project. Over \$3.5 million has been raised.

The Matthew 25 Build will begin in late April (weather permitting) and continue through the end of the year. The goal for this separate project is \$60,000.

Updated info — there is no ‘match’ this year through Community Foundation. With overwhelming response last year, the fund needs time to build further in order to offer the match.
